<i>Perfumed, fruit forward style with ripe black berry fruit and a touch of spice. Great with steak.</i>

<i>Aromas of blackberries, plums, cassis and violets. Smooth and complex flavours, with a core of ripe black fruits.</i>				
<b>26. Barbera d’Asti “Monte Colombo”, Marchesi di Grésy</b> PIEMONTE, ITALY	-	-	-	59.50
<i>Super-ripe aromas of red berry and cherry fruit, hints of blackberry conserve and liquorice, enveloped in sweet toasty vanilla oak. The palate is generous and rich, showing concentrated but soft black fruits and smoky spicy, chocolatey notes.</i>

<i>An attractive, modern style of Crianza with lifted aromatics of bramble fruit with some pepper and spice. Substantial on the palate, with plummy fruit, ripe tannins and a gently savoury fresh finish.</i>				
<b>29. Cariñena/Garnacha/Syrah “Purgatori” Familia Torres</b> COSTERS DEL SEGRE, SPAIN	-	-	-	45.00
<i>Beautiful dark cherry red color. Exquisite red forest fruit (raspberry, redcurrant) aroma with deep, jammy undertones of cherry. Intense on the palate, with delicate, elegant, fine-grained tannins. A wine of exceptional personality.</i>				
<b>30. Château Labastide Dauzac, Margaux</b> BORDEAUX, FRANCE	-	-	-	55.00
<i>The palate is full and elegant, immediately conveying the pedigree of this wine. The tannins are full and refined. They provide nice freshness with notes of Morello cherries to finish.</i>

<i>Golden color with amber reflexes. The aroma is rich and recalls honey, walnuts and raisins. The taste is slightly sweet, velvety and harmonic with caramel, almonds and ripe apple aftertaste.</i>

<i>Full-bodied, with fragrant blackberry aromas and rich black fruit on the palate.</i>
